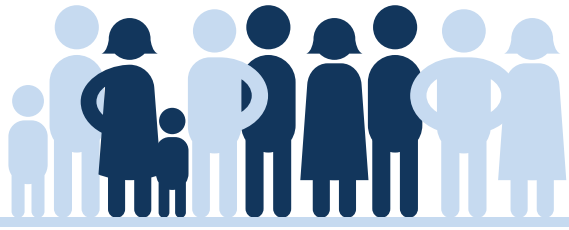

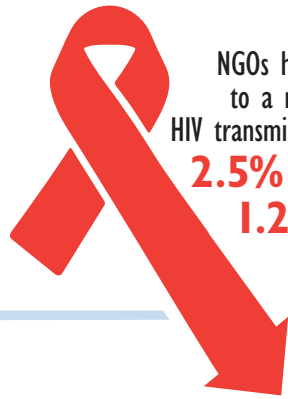
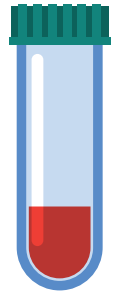

In Guyana, non-governmental organizations (NGOs) provide up to **50%** of all services for people living with HIV.



In 2017, NGOs performed **31%** of Guyana's HIV testing, most of it among key populations.

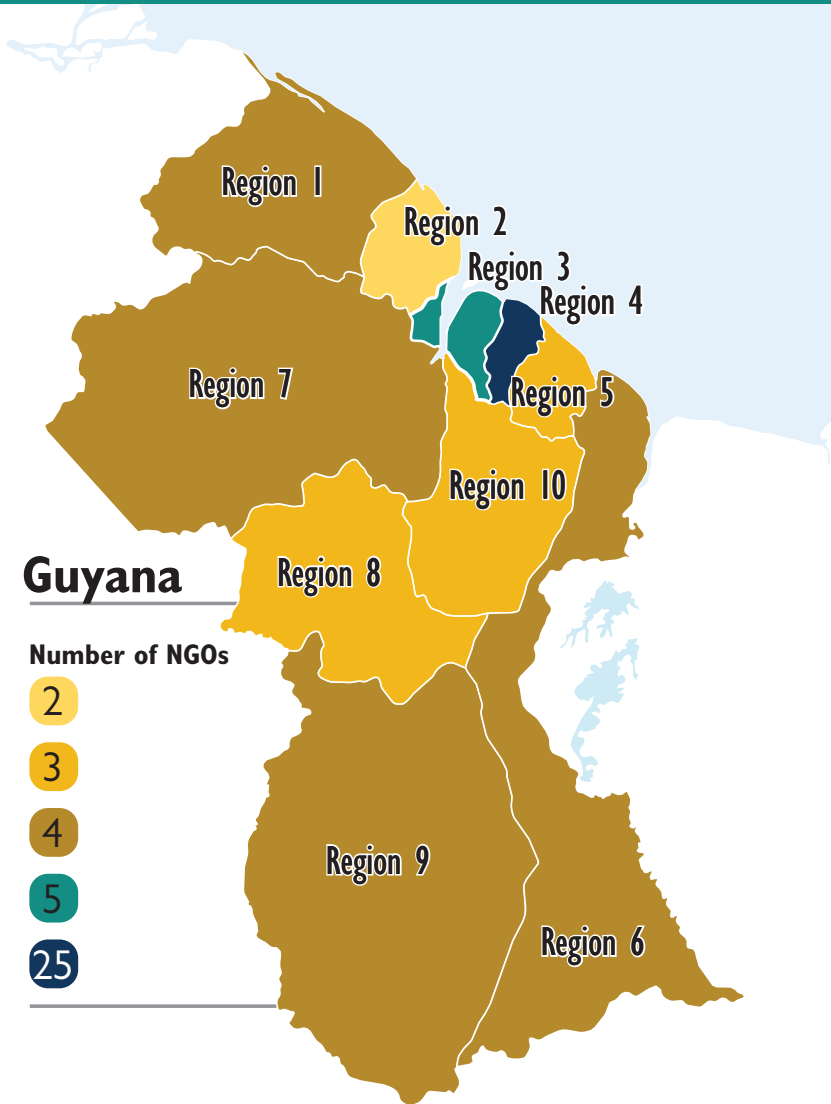


NGOs have contributed to a reduction in the HIV transmission rate, from **2.5% in 2000** to **1.2% in 2015**.



Decreasing financial support for NGOs is jeopardizing the sustainability of the NGOs' response to social challenges.
